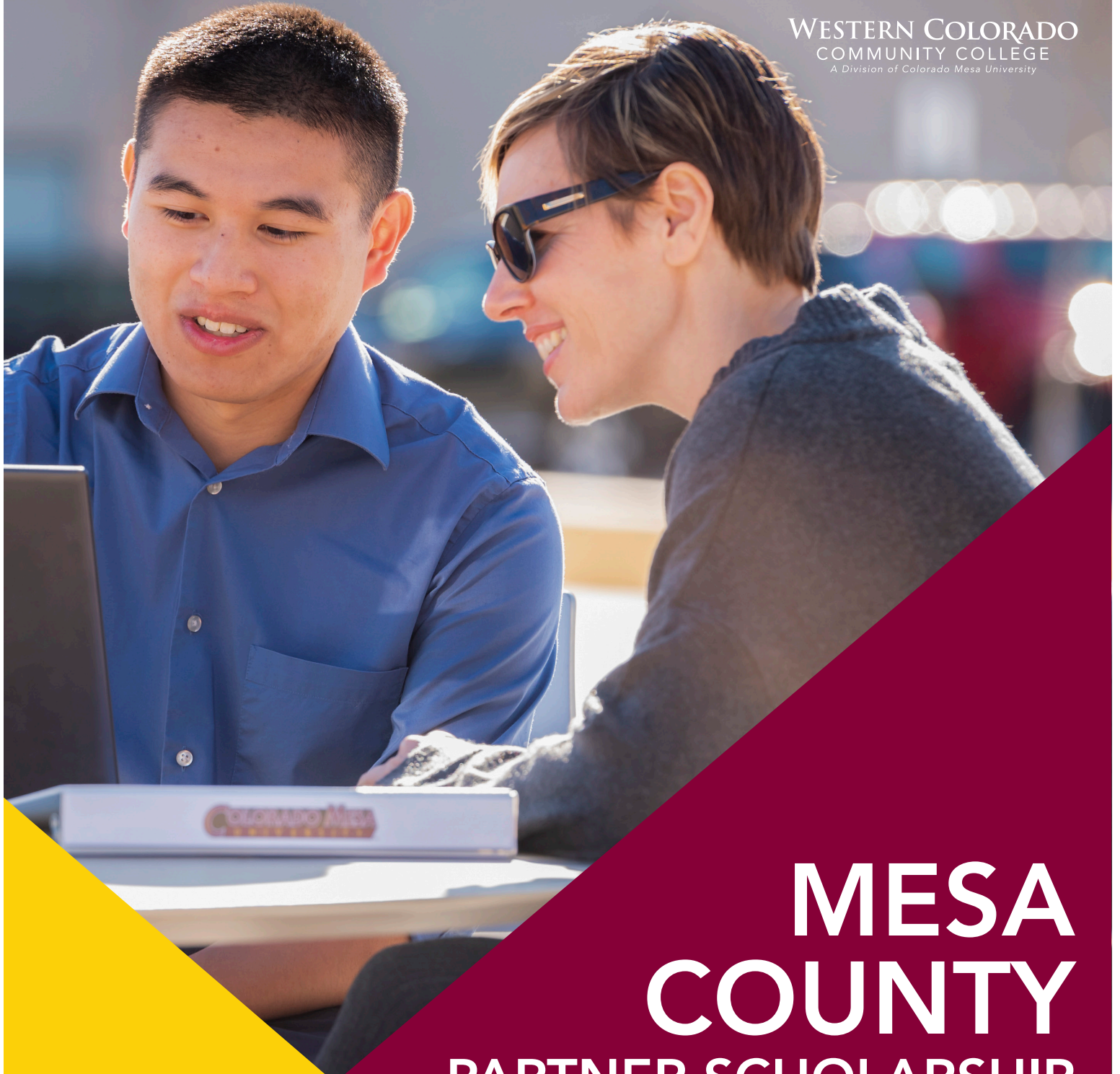

Eligibility Criteria:

- Available to non-traditional students 24 years of age or older.
- Provide proof of employment (e.g. paystub, employee ID) prior to each semester.
- Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress as published in the CMU catalog.

\*\*Capped at 120 credit hours for a bachelor's degree, 60 credit hours for an associate degree, or the length of the number of hours needed to complete a certificate program. The total credit hour allowance includes any transfer credits.
